EXERCISE X (DEL 4 ...)

- Go find a parent theme – not Twenty Ten
- Develop child theme and give it your own design, including
 - background color / image
 - font choice(s)
 - header
 - overall look & feel
- I expect you to test your work internally, and upload to your school domain via Dreamweaver. If you cannot introduce me to your work – and I want to meet both child and parent) – including your work process on your portable on delivery day, I expect a folder of screen dumps illustrating the whole thing.

EXERCISE A: INTERNAL

- Set up a complete internal PHP test milieu, and remember to include
 - a MySQL database (tip: the AMP stack)
 - the WordPress package (tip: www or htdocs)
 - Finally test your good work (tip: localhost/the name of your wp-installation folder)

EXERCISE B: THE PARENT

- Go look for a parent theme
- Install

EXERCISE C: THE CHILD

- Create a basic child of Twenty Ten, using Dreamweaver, on your localhost
- Test by changing description and version no.

EXERCISE D: EXTERNAL

- Connect to your self hosted (online) WordPress installation via Dreamweaver
- Upload your Child of Twenty Ten via DW
- Add yet another child theme (via DW)

EXERCISE E: EXPORT/IMPORT

- Go to your wordpress.com installation – Del. 1
- Export
- Go to your wordpress.org installation – Del 5 (www.cfcXX.webkn.dk) – and import

EXERCISE F: EXPORT/IMPORT

- Change background and font colors utilizing
 - the cascade principle and
 - Dreamweaver's CSS panel
- Set up two different versions – one locally and one online
- Let me see your two versions – and let me see you make sure the two are identical without spending more than 10 seconds on the procedure (tip: put)

EXERCISE G: OVERRIDING

- Import TwentyTen Style sheet
- Use DW CSS panel or hand write the CSS code to override (as a minimum):
 - background color
 - font-family
- Upload your work and let me have a look see
- Is something wrong with the background color, do you think? If so, what might that be?

EXERCISE H: GOOGLE TOOLS

- Change the background color – the entire background color – both locally and online utilizing:
 - Google Development Tools
 - Dreamweaver CSS panel
 - Dreamweaver upload facilities
